Enclosed for your review is the scholarship program deadlines for the 2020 Prince Hall Memorial Education and Scholarship Fund (PHMESF). The application is available online for prospective applicants, and it may be downloaded from the Grand Lodge website at <https://www.mwphglcal.org/>.

Please note the following deadlines for submission of the application materials.

- Applicants are to submit completed applications to their local lodge by no later than **May 1st**.
- Each lodge must then review, select, and submit their selections to their District Deputy Grand Master (DDGM) by **May 16th**.
- The DDGM is to submit the top three applications from their district by no later than **June 5th**.
- Award notifications will be provided to the DDGM's by no later than **June 30th**.

Applications should be reviewed and submitted at the earliest opportunity to the DDGM's. However, only the top three will be submitted by the DDGM to the PHMESF for consideration.


Pursuant to our process, scholarship application submissions must come directly from the DDGM. Any applications that have not been processed by the DDGM will not be reviewed by the PHMESF.

Please note, that pursuant to Edict #1 issued by our Most Worshipful Grand Master, Samuel T. King, on August 5, 2018, any lodge which is not in compliance with this directive will be ineligible for participation in the scholarship program.
